Measles is highly contagious and can live for up to 2 hours in the air.

Measles spreads through coughing and sneezing.



Call your doctor immediately if you think you or your child have been exposed. To avoid potentially spreading measles, please do not show up without calling.

Up to 90% of people near you (who are not immune) will also a become infected.



Symptoms usually begin 7 to 14 days after infection.
